Widows

- Deficiency, chasm,vacancy
 - Robbed, deprived
 - Extreme poverty1 Kings 17:8–16Luke 20:46–21:4

Honor Widows

- Widows are under God's special care and protection Psalm 68:5
- God provides for widows Deuteronomy 24:19–22
- God blesses those who help widows Jeremiah 7:5–7
- God punishes those who harm widows Exodus 22:22–24
- God has compassion on widows Luke 7:11–15

1 Timothy 5:4

⁴ But if any widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn to show piety at home and to repay their parents; for this is good and acceptable before God.

- Not "genuine" widows
- Honor your father and your mother

1 Timothy 5:5

5 Now she who is really a widow, and left alone, trusts in God and continues in supplications and prayers night and day.

- Left alone: no supporting family (v4)
- Trusts in God: Christian
- Continues in prayers (Luke 2:36–38)
