## Ephesians 6:9

Who? Masters
What + ? Do the same things to your slaves
What - ? Give up threatening
Why? You and your slaves have a Master without partiality

## Ephesians 6:5 (NASB)

Slaves, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in the sincerity of your heart, as to Christ;

1 Corinthians 7:17-24 1 Peter 2:13-25

# Ephesians 6:6 (NASB)

not by way of eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as slaves of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart.

## Ephesians 6:7 (NASB)

With good will render service, as to the Lord, and not to men,

# Ephesians 6:8 (NASB)

knowing that whatever good thing each one does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether slave or free.

## Ephesians 6:9 (NASB)

And, masters, do the same things to them, and give up threatening, knowing that both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no partiality with Him.

### Ephesians 6:5–9

Slaves, obey and respect your masters. Work sincerely, diligently, to please the Lord. The Lord will repay every good thing.

Masters, respect your slaves, don't threaten them. You have a Master, too.
