The Gospel According to John

- Writer:** The disciple whom Jesus loved (13:23; 21:20)
The Apostle John
- Date of writing:** Unknown (A.D. 80 – 98)
- Themes:** "I AM" statements
Miracles, signs
Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God
- Purpose:** So that the reader may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and have life in His name (20:30–31)
