
The **Gospel** According to **John**

John 1:6–8

⁶ There was a man having been sent from God, whose name was John. ⁷ He came as a witness, to bear witness about the Light, so that all might believe through him. ⁸ He was not the Light, but he came to bear witness about the Light.

Luke 1:13–17

<u>Christ</u>

- a. was from all eternity (v1, 2)
- b. is the Word (v1)
- c. is Himself God (v1, 2)
- d. is the real Light (v4, 5, 9)
- e. is the Object of trust (v7-9)

John (the Baptist)

a. came (v6) b. was a mere man (v6) c. was commissioned by God (v6) d. came to testify concerning the real Light (v7, 8) e. was the agent through whose testimony men come to trust in the real Light, Christ (v7-9)
