# John 1:35–36

<sup>35</sup> On the next day, John again was standing with two of his disciples, <sup>36</sup> and he looked at Jesus as He walked, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!"

# John 1:37

<sup>37</sup> And the two disciples heard him speak and followed Jesus.

# John 1:38

<sup>38</sup> And when Jesus turned and noticed them following, He said to them, "What do you seek?" They said to Him, "Rabbi (which translated means Teacher), where are You staying?"

# John 1:39

<sup>39</sup> He said to them, "Come, and you will see." So they came and saw where He was staying, and they stayed with Him that day. It was about the tenth hour.

# John 1:40–41

<sup>40</sup> One of the two who heard John speak and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. <sup>41</sup> He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which translated means Christ).



# John 1:42

<sup>42</sup> He brought him to Jesus. When Jesus looked at him, He said, "You are Simon the son of John; you shall be called Cephas" (which is translated Peter).
