# **John 8**

## **Jesus Teaches in the Temple**

**I. He teaches all the people (8:1–12)**

**– interrupted by a group of scribes and Pharisees (8:3–11)**

**II. Dialogue with the Pharisees (8:13–30)**

**III. Dialogue with Jews who had "believed" Him (8:31–59)**

**(1) I am the bread of life (6:35, 48)**

**– I am the living bread that came down from heaven (6:51)**

**(2) I am the Light of the world (8:12; 9:5)**

**(3) I am the door of the sheep (10:7)**

**– I am the door (10:9)**

**(4) I am the good shepherd (10:11, 14)**

**(5) I am the resurrection and the life (11:25)**

**(6) I am the way, and the truth, and the life (14:6)**

**(7) I am the true vine (15:1)**

**– I am the vine (15:5)**
