Jesus Teaches in the Temple

I. He teaches all the people (8:1–12)

– interrupted by a group of scribes and Pharisees (8:3–11)

II. Dialogue with the Pharisees (8:13–30)

III. Dialogue with Jews who had "believed" Him (8:31–59)
