#### **Abide**

- 1. To wait; to pause; to delay
- 2. To stay; to continue in a place; to have one's abode; to dwell; to sojourn
- 3. To remain stable or fixed in some state or condition; to continue; to remain

### μένω

To stay (in a given place, state, relation or expectancy)

To remain, abide. Not to depart, not to leave, to continue to be present, to maintain unbroken fellowship with one

## John 15:4

<sup>4</sup> "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit from itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me."

## John 15:5

<sup>5</sup> "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing."

## John 15:6

<sup>6</sup> "If anyone does not abide in Me, he is thrown away as a branch and dries up; and they gather them, and cast them into the fire and they are burned."
