¹⁴ "He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you."

John 16:15

¹⁵ "All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose it to you."

John 3:5–8	born of the Spirit
John 3:34	God gives the Spirit
John 7:37–39	rivers of living water; after Jesus glorified
John 14:16–17	another Advocate, with you forever
John 14:26	will teach, bring to remembrance
John 15:26–27	will bear witness about Me
John 16:7–15	will convict world; guide disciples in truth
