# Habakkuk 1:15

<sup>15</sup> The Chaldeans bring all of them up with a hook,  
Drag them away with their net,  
And gather them together in their fishing net.  
Therefore they are glad and rejoice.

<sup>16</sup> Therefore they offer a sacrifice to their net  
And burn incense to their fishing net  
Because through these things their portion is rich  
And their food is fat.
