## Exhortations

**Remember** the words of the apostles

**Remain** (keep yourselves) in the love of God

## Jude 22–23

<sup>22</sup> And on **some** have compassion, making a distinction; <sup>23</sup> but **others** save with fear, pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garment defiled by the flesh. (NKJV)

<sup>22</sup> And have mercy on **some**, who are doubting; <sup>23</sup> save **others**, snatching them out of the fire; and on **some** have mercy with fear, hating even the garment polluted by the flesh. (NASB)

## Jude 22

22 And on some have compassion,  
making a distinction;

ἐλεᾶτε to have mercy

διακρινομένους to distinguish or decide

make distinction, show partiality

doubt, waver

## Jude 23

23 but others save with **fear**, pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garment defiled by the flesh.

**φόβω** terror, fear, dread; reverence
